

BYLAW NO. 129.

A bylaw to authorize the issue of permits for the operation of overweight vehicles on certain roads.

The council of the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292 of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any bylaw heretofore or hereafter enacted by the council under the authority of paragraph 35 or 36 of section 190 (1) of The Rural Municipality Act prohibiting the same, it shall be lawful for any person who obtains a permit for that purpose under section 2 hereof, to operate a vehicle, or fleet of vehicles, upon any road in the municipality at a time or during a period, and subject to the terms and conditions as set forth in this bylaw and in such permit.
2. The secretary treasurer of the municipality is hereby authorized to issue permits for the purpose of this bylaw, subject to the following conditions, to wit:
 - (a) each application for a permit shall be accompanied by a fee of \$5.00;
 - (b) each permit issued shall describe the vehicle or vehicles to which it relates, state the license numbers, the name of the licensee of each vehicle, fix the maximum weight (with load) which each vehicle may carry under the permit, and state the road or roads to which the permit applies, and the time and period during which the vehicle or vehicles referred to therein may so operate;
 - (c) a copy of each permit issued shall be conspicuously affixed to each vehicle to which it relates, during any time or period in respect of which it is effective;
 - (d) every applicant for permit shall before receiving the same:
 - (i) acknowledge in writing that he has read and understands this bylaw and will comply with its terms and conditions;
 - (ii) give a written undertaking that he will pay the municipality upon demand such sum as may be required to remedy any damage caused to the road or roads described in the permit through the operation thereon of any vehicle or vehicles to which the permit applies.
3. Nothing in this bylaw or in any permit issued hereunder shall be construed as authorizing the permit holder to operate:
 - (a) any vehicle upon any road in the municipality which is a provincial highway as defined under The Highways and Transportation Act;
 - (b) any vehicle upon any road in the municipality other than the road or roads expressly described in the permit;
 - (c) any vehicle on any road within the municipality other than a vehicle as described in the permit;
 - (d) any vehicle upon any road within the municipality having a weight (with load) exceeding the maximum as stated in the permit;
 - (e) any vehicle upon any road in the municipality except at the time and during the period specified in the permit.
