

**RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MILTON NO. 292**  
**BYLAW 2019-07**

**A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROTECTION OF PUBLIC WATER SUPPLIES**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw:
  - a. Vehicle means a vehicle as defined in *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*
  - b. Resident means a person who resides in the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292.
  - c. Ratepayer means a person or corporation who pays municipal taxes to the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292.
  - d. Irrigation means the supply of non-potable or potable water to agriculture land or crops to facilitate growth.
  - e. Agriculture land means land devoted to agriculture and is used to grow food products.
  - f. Crop means a cultivated plant that is grown as food or feed.
  
2. The following water supply locations shall be designated as public water supplies for the purposes of providing residents and ratepayers with non-potable water for agricultural use only. This does not include irrigation, or the hauling of water for irrigation purposes.
  - Site 1 - NE 10-28-29W3 - Alsask Water Treatment Plant Fill Station
  - Site 2 - SW 32-29-27W3 - known as the Marengo North dugout
  - Site 3 - Block A Plan 101910923 located in the NE 11-29-28W3 - known as the Jeffries Spring
  - Site 4 - SE 01-30-29W3 - known as the Sonmor well
  
3. Water shall not be removed for any purpose from the NE 31-27-28W3 owned by the municipality located in the Rural Municipality of Chesterfield No. 261.
  
4. Water obtained from municipal wells, dugouts and fill stations must immediately be placed in a holding tank and transported from the well site or dugout.
  
5. No person shall:
  - a. Fill any chemical spray apparatus or have a spraying apparatus within 30 metres of any of the designated public water supplies.
  - b. Wash or rinse off a vehicle at any of the designated public water supplies.
  
6. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offense and is liable to a penalty of \$1,000.00.

7. Where any person has committed or is alleged to have committed a breach of any of the provision of this Bylaw, a ticket, notice or summons may be served on such person by a Police Officer, Municipal Bylaw Enforcement Officer, Peace Officer or any person duly authorized by council. Such person served with a ticket or notice may voluntarily pay same at the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292 Administration Office between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., excepting Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays, provided that payment is made within a period of ten (10) days from the service said ticket or notice. If payment is made within such time and accepted, then that person shall not be liable to prosecution for the offense.
8. Service of a ticket, notice, or summons pursuant to this Bylaw may be made by:
  - a. By personally delivering the ticket, notice, or summons to the person committing the breach of the provision of this Bylaw; or
  - b. By mailing such ticket, notice, or summons to the last known address of the person committing the breach by registered mail.
9. A person to whom a Notice of Violation is being issued pursuant to this Bylaw, shall upon request, provide their name and address. Any person who fails to provide this information is guilty of an offense and liable on summary conviction to be assessed a fine as outline in the most current Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292 General Penalties Bylaw.
10. Bylaw No. 2011-01 is hereby repealed.
