



## Current Bereavement Policy

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### **BEREAVEMENT LEAVE**

**2021-150 PETER APPLIN** – That effective May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 all employees be granted twenty eight hour paid days for bereavement leave due to the death of immediate family and ten eight hour paid days due to the death of an extended family member, paid days off to be taken within the period commencing on the death of the family member and ending six months after the death of the family member; the definition of “immediate family” as taken from *The Labour Standards Act* is as follows:

“Immediate family” means a spouse, parent, grandparent, child, brother or sister of an employee or of a spouse.”


