Fencing Policy

All newly constructed or reconstructed fencing must be placed at least 0.5 metres onto the owner's property

The municipality is not responsible for locating the municipal road allowance property line

The municipality is not responsible for any fence that is placed on the municipal road allowance. Any removal costs will be invoiced to the ratepayer.

Fencing - Road Construction

The municipality will be responsible for paying for the cost of the labour for the removal of any existing fence. The municipality will be responsible for paying for posts 3-4 inches x 6 feet placed at a minimum of 25 feet apart and the replacement of existing gates and for the installation of such, minus any wire.

If the landowner/occupant wishes to upgrade the fence past the municipal standards as listed above, all costs for the extra or new material will be invoiced to the landowner/occupant. The municipality will supply the labour.

The owner shall be responsible for the cost of all wire and for costs relating to any difference in post size, placement, wire or gates from the original construction. If an electric fence is being erected, the owner shall be responsible for the cost of the wire and insulators.

Adjacent landowners to road construction projects shall be requested to move cattle to another holding area during construction. In the event that moving the cattle is not possible, then the following shall apply:

The municipality shall install an electric fence where possible;

If an electric fence is not possible, then the municipality will install a two wire fence;

The municipality shall be responsible for the removal of all temporary fencing as soon as possible upon completion of the new fence construction.

The municipality shall remove all old fencing material as soon as possible after the road construction is complete, the old fencing material is property of the municipality.

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Snow Removal Policy

Custom Snow Removal

Municipal roads will be plowed to agricultural yard sites if time allows.

There will be a half hour minimum charge on snow removal in agricultural yards.

Route plowed to agricultural yard sites will be at the discretion of the division councillor.

Grader will not go out for just one request for snow removal.

Residential yard sites will be plowed up to the residence free of charge if the grader is in the area.

Custom snow plowing form must be completed and signed before snow removal will start.

Municipal Snow Removal

Snow removal will begin when the snowfall stops or is expected to stop shortly.

Snow removal will not take place when visibility is less than 300 metres.


If the snow falls ends the evening before or during the night, snow clearing operations will begin the following morning.

Equipment and employees will be dispatched for snow removal at the Foreman's discretion.

For extreme snow fall events, laid off seasonal workers and/or contractors will be used to remove the snow.


