Re: Merid School

Dear RM of Milton Council Members:

As per the request of Reeve Mr. David Bond, I am writing to update the RM council on the renovations currently being completed and planned for the future on the Merid School site. I am also asking your permission to proceed with these plans.

The following renovations have been completed so far on the school:

- * The old roof could not be saved and needed to be removed. It was removed and new engineered trusses have been installed. The trusses needed to be up to current safety code and therefore were engineered to be 1% different than the old pitch, and 6-8 inches higher than the old pitch. This pitch also has the advantage of securing the original brick chimney which is weak and needs repointing in the future. These trusses do not permit a flat ceiling inside the school as there was before, so when completed the ceiling will be vaulted. (there were in fact two ceilings in the school; the original one and then three feet below that a false ceiling had been constructed to accommodate wiring for lights). These trusses allowed the contractor also to straighten the walls of the school.
- * There are sofit and facia being added as well.
- * the roof was completed with Midnight Black Malarkey shingles that are designed to look like cedar shingles but are in fact not. They have a 50 year warranty and are high end shingles designed to withstand high winds, severe hail etc. I decided on the black color as it was conducive to 1912 painted shingle colors. It was not possible nor feasible to replace the cedar shingles due to extreme cost and the need for future repair. Working on this high a pitch is difficult work.
- * A large crack in the cement foundation on the porch addition was repaired.
- * The remains of old steps/decking in front of the two doors of the school have been removed. Plans are for a wooden deck and metal railings to be built on the east side door. The door on the south or road side will be simple steps for now with plans to make the building wheelchair accessible in the future.

The following renovations are planned:

- * The west wall of the school needs to be dismantled and reinforced. It is a weak wall.
- * the north wall has two areas that have rot from years of moisture seeping into it. It will be dismantled and repaired.
- * the school will be insulated from the inside with appropriate materials to code.

- * There were four original windows exposed prior to this renovation. Four additional original windows were discovered: an elliptical window was found inside the school on the east wall. Unfortunately it had been covered up with the addition of the porch post 1912. It is intact and will remain where it is, seen from inside the school only. Another elliptical window was discovered on the south wall above the large windows. It was not salvageable. It will be replaced by a similar replica. Two additional windows were discovered, one on either side of the four large south facing windows, totalling six windows. These windows will be all be replaced with replica windows as none are salvageable. I anticipate replacing glass only in the remaining upstairs windows in the future, as the frames are fine. I any other windows are discovered in the exterior and interior work, they will be replaced only if needed.
- * The two exterior doors will be replaced with replica 1912 doors which will be metal and I will stain them to look like wood. The south door was added after the original school was built and when it was added it covered up part of one of the windows. Therefore the door will be moved over in order to reinstall the window.

The exterior wood siding (currently under a layer of grey asphalt shingles) will be salvaged and refinished as much as possible. Any new siding will be wood and will match the design of the existing wood as closely as possible. This wood will be primed and painted white and will have the historic green trim (matched from existing wood trim discovered under the asphalt siding) painted as well.

- * the inside walls will be stripped of the panel board that was added over the existing 1912 tongue and groove boards. As many of these original boards will be salvaged and refinished. Any new boards added to or replaced on the inside of the school will be wood and matched as closely to the original as possible.
- * The wood covering the brick chimney will be dismantled in order to expose the brick.
- * The original interior doors going to the basement and to the bathroom will remain. The door going into the hall will be replaced by an old door I own that will match the era better than the one that is on it currently.
- * the kitchen will be gutted and replaced with historically correct cabinets. The existing cupboards had a great deal of pigeon damage and they are not 1912 original as there was not a kitchen in the school at that time.
- * The oak floors will be refinished and restored as they were in 1912. The floors are not level and we may need to fix them in the future. We are currently looking at options.
- * the electrical will be updated and connected once it is up to code.
- * The building will be heated in the future. We are not sure at this time how. Currently looking into propane.
- * Future plans are also to put septic and cistern systems on the site to allow water and sewer. The old septic tank currently in the basement of the school will be dismantled and removed.
- * there will be three new steel teleposts installed in basement for better support.

I hope that I have covered everything. The reason I purchased this site and school was to restore it as closely as I can to its original 1912 construction. However, in order to do this, I need to consider current building codes and safety as well as cost. I understand that this is not a 100% true restoration, but I am trying to keep it as original as I possibly can. This school has been enjoyed by generations of community members, and as a result has many layers of different decades that I am attempting to peel away. It is a little bit of history that I am happy to be able to keep erect, and hopefully enjoyed again.

I am taking many photographs of each stage of construction. I will provide those to you if you wish for
